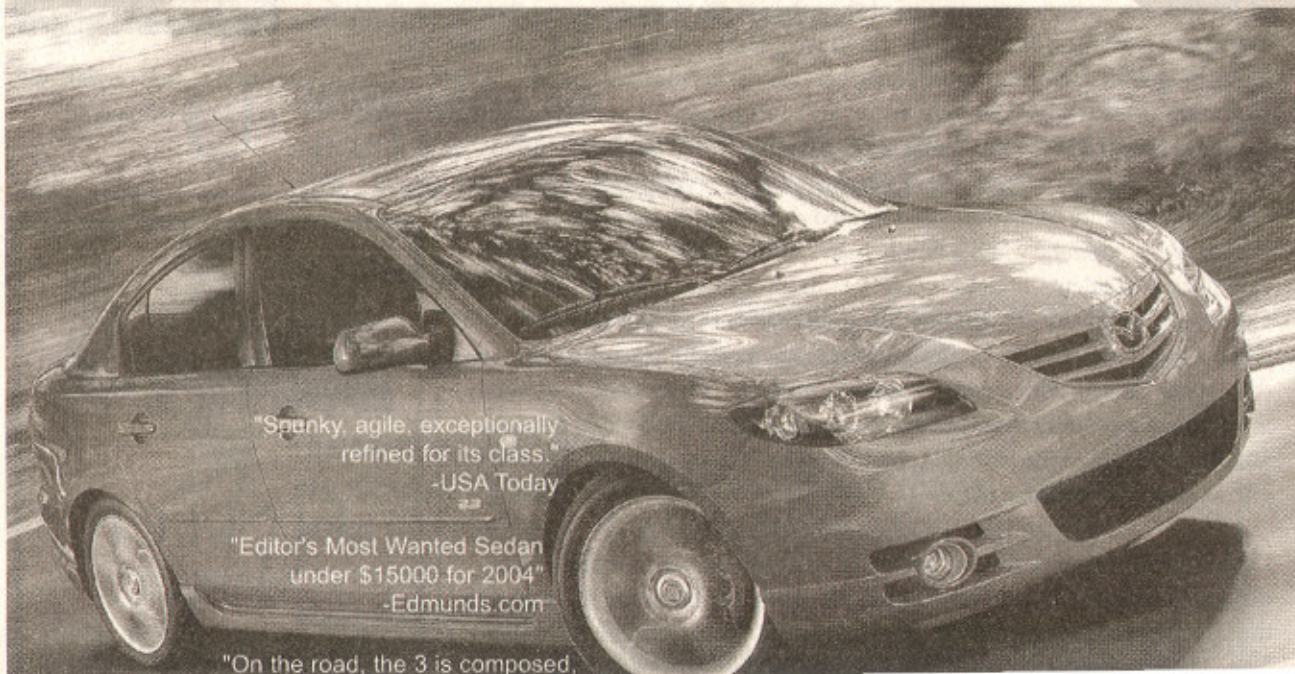
"The Triplets," for example, are three distractions that follow her all her life. Only later in the story does she discover their real identities; fame, flattery, and fantasy.
